

Use of Force

This section seeks to provide a summary of each incident that involved the Use of Force. There were six incidents in the month of February.

18000708 - Officers responded to a reported Breaking & Entering in progress. Upon arrival officers observed a man attempting to kick out a stairwell window. When officers instructed the man to stop, he turned towards the officers and began to charge upstairs at the officers in an unruly manner. The officers proceeded to release OC spray on the man. He fell backwards downstairs and the officers were able to arrest him. Prior to officer's arrival, the man kicked and pulled the hair of two residents after breaking into their apartment.

18000867 - Officers were called to control an unruly crowd in front of La Fabrica nightclub. Officers then observed a male strike another male in the face with a closed fist. The officer grabbed the male and brought him to the ground to place him in handcuffs.

18000868 - A male was causing a disturbance after exiting La Fabrica nightclub. The male was noncompliant with officer requests to move along and stay out of the street. A struggle ensued once officers attempted to arrest the male. The male was brought down to the ground and effectively arrested.

18000967 - A group of teenagers were arguing over stolen money that the male party arrested refused to return. While officers were speaking with the victim, the male continued to charge at the victim, yelling and screaming at her. Officers continuously asked the male to stop, to which he did not comply. Officers attempted to place the male in handcuffs, but he began to flail his limbs in an effort to resist. Force was used to take the male down to the ground in order to make the arrest.

18001181 - A man trespassed into his girlfriend's apartment, struck her over the head with a box of food and was yelling and screaming in her face. Officers arrived and attempted to arrest the man, he began to resist. The officers took the man down onto the bed inside the apartment, and one officer used an open-palm to strike the man in the face to force compliance. The officers were then able to make the arrest.

18001255 - A male grabbed two women on the street in Central Square. Officers responded and attempted to control the man while officers spoke with the victims. The man then punched an officer in the left shoulder, at which point the officers attempted to arrest the man. He resisted arrest, leading to the officers taking the man down to the ground face first.

Use of Force

This section seeks to provide a summary of each incident that involved the Use of Force. There were four incidents in the month of March.

18001378 - A male reported that his bike had been stolen and observed a young black male riding his bicycle. Officers pursued the black male after he dumped the bike in a front yard and began running from police. The officer grabbed the male by his upper arms in order to stop him from running and was able to put the male under arrest.

18001757 - A male known to police to have mental health issues and to be combative with law enforcement was observed by Target loss prevention shoplifting items from the electronics department with a paring knife that was shoplifted from the same store earlier that day. Upon

arrival, the officer drew his department issued firearm, pointed it at the male, and instructed the male to drop the knife he was holding. The male was compliant and was arrested without incident. (26)(c)

18001788 - A male was acting out of control, screaming gibberish, and kicked a passing ambulance. When officers arrived, they were unable to make verbal contact with the male due to his behavior. The male was arrested for his safety and the safety of the officers, PRO personnel and the public. The male strongly and violently resisted arrest, leading to the officers taking the male down to the ground in order to effect the arrest.

18001914 - A patron at the Sinclair became out of control and unruly after being served alcohol. CPD responded to arrest the man after the man fought with security personnel. The man continued to resist officers and OC spray was used in an attempt to force his compliance. Once handcuffed, the man was carried out of the building due to his continuous efforts to resist and was transported (26)(c)

18002152 - A homeless male rode a bicycle through an intersection in Harvard square, running a red light, nearly hitting multiple pedestrians, and ignored requests by the officer to stop on his bicycle. When the male approached the officer, the male attempted to swerve around the officer as he was asked to stop. The officer grabbed the male's arm in an attempt to stop him. The male and the officer fell to the ground and the male was arrested for his bicycle violations.

18002308 - A man was standing completely naked in the median of Mass Ave exhibiting hostile and uncontrollable behavior. It became known to officers that this man was under the influence of some type of psychoactive hallucinogen. The officers tackled to man from behind to the ground. A struggle ensued while officer attempted to place the man in handcuffs. The man was flailing and kicking. The officers delivered closed fist blows to the man's stomach and head areas in order to force compliance. An impact weapon was used to pry the man's left arm from underneath him. The officers' efforts were strongly resisted, but the force used successfully aided the officers in making the arrest.

18002424 - 41 § 97D When officers attempted to arrest the male, he began to resist and attempted to run from the officers. The officers brought the male to the ground in order to effect the arrest.

18002683 - Two individuals, known to the officer to be homeless and to have issues in the past, were placed under arrest for causing damaged to a wall partition inside the Central Square McDonald's after the parties engaged in a brawl inside the restaurant. One of the individuals resisted arrest by pulling his left arm away from the officer. The officer pinned the individual up against a trash can and moved the male's watch in order to secure the individual in handcuffs.

18004571 - Officers responded to a call for service at Hong Kong Restaurant for an unwanted male. The male then left Hong Kong and sat at the bar inside Grafton Street Pub. Officers ordered the male to leave on several occasions and the male refused and asked officers unintelligible questions. The officers physically removed the male with some struggle and brought the male to the ground outside in order to handcuff him.

18004691 - Officers completed a MV stop following a 911 hang-up. The male driver had a suspended license and was in possession of marijuana and crack cocaine. As officers began to arrest the male, he took off running. Officers were able to catch up to him, tackled him to the ground, and struck the male twice in the ribs with a closed fist in order to effect his arrest when the male actively resisted.

18004937 - Officer responded to a residence for reports of an unwanted person. Upon arrival a male was acting uncontrollably, screaming and was not listening to officer's orders to leave the premise. Officers were able to get the male down on his knees and handcuff him for his safety.

The individual began to resist when being placed on the stretcher. Officers administered a knee strike to the individual's thigh in order to get the individual securely onto the stretcher.

18005005 - Officers responded to a disturbance at a commercial address. A male walking away from the address would not comply with officer demands to return to the store to resolve the issue. Due to this male's noncompliance, the officer placed the individual in handcuffs while using his cruiser for leverage. The handcuffs were then removed once the officer no longer felt unsafe.

Use of Force

This section seeks to provide a summary of each incident that involved the Use of Force. There were eleven incidents in the month of August.

18005278 - Officers responded to the Cambridge Probate Court for reports of an individual standing outside with chains around his hands and feet. Upon arrival the male began acting out of control and would not comply with officers when told they would be taking the chains off of him. The officers brought the individual down to the ground and handcuffed him for his and officer safety.

18005282 - Officers responded to a parked trailer truck for a well-being check requested by the trucking company. Officers made contact with the driver inside the truck and the driver exited. The officers pat frisked the driver for weapons, and the driver then became aggressive. Officers pursued the driver on foot as he ran from officers. The driver was caught, brought to the ground in a prone position and arrested.

18005447 - Officers stopped a male bicyclist for bicycle violations. The male subsequently gave officers two different names and would not comply with officers. The officers then attempted to arrest the male at which point he resisted violently. Officers pinned the male up against a wall and struck the male twice in the back with a closed fist in order to subdue him to place the male in handcuffs.

18005473 - Officers made a MV stop regarding a 911 call regarding a male who appeared to be waving a black firearm around inside his vehicle. Officers drew their department issued firearms as they approached the vehicle. The driver complied with officers' orders. The officers handcuffed the individual for officer safety while searching the vehicle. Officers recovered a BB gun and the driver decided to voluntarily give up the BB gun to officers.

18005490 - Officers responded to Harvard Yard for reports of a distressed female. Upon arrival, officers were confronted by a male party who was in the company of the female. This male became very aggressive and verbally assaultive towards officers. Officers then learned this male had active warrants, and as they attempted to place him under arrest, the male began to flail his arms and actively resist. The officers struggled with the male, brought him to the ground and handcuffed him.

18005670 - Officers responded to TD Bank for reports of an individual attempting to withdraw money from an account that was previously used to deposit a fraudulent check. Upon arrival, officers were met with resistance as they attempted to arrest the male. The male was brought to the ground in a prone position, officers used their batons in an effort to pry the male's arms from under him.

18005733 - Officers responded to the area of Clement Morgan Park for reports of shots fired. Following a search of the area a suspect was located. The male was ordered to stop by police, he did not comply and subsequently began to run from officers. The individual was tackled to the ground and successfully arrested.

18005781 - Officers responded to Boston Burger Company for a report of an unwanted person. When officers arrived, the individual refused to leave and became aggressively combative with officers. The officers pinned the male up against the glass window while trying to gain control of his wrists to handcuff him. The male tried punching the officers, and at this time the officers used a knee strike to the back of the male's legs to get him on the ground where he was finally handcuffed.

18005921 - Officers were called to a residential area for reports of a male and female running through yards acting erratically. Officers located the male inside a porta-potty. The officers rocked the porta-potty back and forth in an attempt to force the male out. As the male came running out of the porta-potty officers deployed one burst of OC spray into the male's face. The male was pinned against a wall, then brought to the ground as the male resisted arrest.

18005982 - Officers conducted a MV stop in regard to a 911 call made about the driver displaying a firearm out of the window. Officers drew their department issued firearms when approaching the vehicle and handcuffed the driver for safety reasons. The driver was compliant, and a search of the driver and vehicle yielded negative results for any firearms.

18006035 - While conducting a drug investigation, detectives attempted to stop a male who they believed to have just conducted a street level drug transaction while he was riding his bike down Mass Ave. Detectives knocked the male off his bike after the male did not comply with their orders for him to stop. The male was placed in handcuffs on the ground.

This section seeks to provide a summary of each incident that involved the Use of Force. There were six incidents in the month of September.

18006432 - While on patrol an officer observed a female he knew to have a warrant. He attempted to place the woman under arrest and she began to resist by pulling away. The officer pinned the woman up against a barrier in order to keep her from pulling away, but she continued to resist. The officer warned the woman that he would spray her with his OC spray if she continued to resist and she immediately stopped.

18006534 - Officer responded to a call at Harvard University for a male overdosing on acid. As the officers escorted the male out of his room by holding onto his arms, the male became combative towards officers. The officers utilized a leg sweep technique to bring the male to the ground where they were able to handcuff him for his and their safety.

18006548 - Officers responded to a call for assistance regarding a male attempting to fight another male at a bus stop. Upon arrival officers instructed both parties to sit down and away from each other. One of the males refused to comply with officer commands to sit down. The

officer was pushed by the male and the officer sprayed the male with his OC spray after multiple warnings.

With continued struggle the officers were able to place the male in the wagon.

When asked a second time the student took a fighting stance and began to swing several punches at the officers. The others grabbed his hands and bear hugged the student from behind, as the student aggressively resisted the officers took the student to the ground.

Use of Force

This section seeks to provide a summary of each incident that involved the Use of Force. There were four incidents in the month of October.

18007072 – Officers responded to this location originally to assess a domestic dispute. A second call was made for officers to return to this location. A man was acting belligerent, screaming at the top of his lungs in a public roadway. When told to calm down or he would be arrested, the male continued with his behavior. Officers attempted to arrest the man by putting his hands behind his back, to which he resisted. Officers forced the male to the ground and held him down in order to get his hands behind his back.

18007214 – Officers conducted a motor vehicle stop on a vehicle that has been considered by neighbors to be an issue in the neighborhood. Upon stopping the vehicle, officers were approached by the driver of the vehicle and his passenger in an unsafe manner. These individuals

refused to comply with officer's orders to get back into the vehicle. Once many more officers arrived on scene the driver was taken into custody with resistance.

18007318 – Officers responded to a disturbance. Upon arrival a male was screaming and threatened to kill himself. Officers explained the male would have to go to the hospital for evaluation. The male became agitated, punched the wall and picked up a glass bowl while taking a fighting stance towards the officers. The officers showed their PR-24 and OC Spray and warned the male to put the bowl down. Once he did officers took the male to the ground and struggled to handcuff him.

18007403 – The officer responded to Seven-Eleven for a report of an unarmed robbery. Upon questioning to suspect and asking him to remove his hands from his pockets, he fled on foot from police. The officer gave chase after the suspect for a short distance. The suspect was ordered to the ground where he was then handcuffed.

Use of Force

This section seeks to provide a summary of each incident that involved the Use of Force. There were four incidents in the month of December.

18008540 – Cambridge Police received notification from UMass Boston Police that a former student of theirs was planning to shoot people at the Galleria Mall and on the UMass campus. Officers responded to the Galleria Mall to locate the individual. An officer had the patrol rifle pointed at the suspect as another officer approached the male with his firearm at the low ready. Upon securing the male in handcuffs without incident no weapons were found in the male's possession.

18008586 – Officers were called to respond to Novartis for an unwanted male party causing a disturbance in the main lobby of the building. The male refused to leave until he was formally trespassed. Once outside in front of the building the male continued to refuse to leave then removed all of his clothing. Officers placed the male under arrest with struggle. The officers performed a knee strike which results in officers and the male to fall to the ground where the male was finally secured.

The male was ordered to stop and he did not comply. Officers pursued the male on a foot, once distance between them were closed, the officer tackled the suspect to the ground and the male was placed under arrest.
