Dear Chief Perez:

I have received the petitions of Andrew Quemere appealing the nonresponse of the Brockton Police Department (Department) to two requests for public records. See G. L. c. 66, § 10A; see also 950 C.M.R. 32.08(1). On June 17, 2026, Mr. Quemere requested the following in two separate requests:

SPR26/2599

“All internal affairs records for [an identified individual]”

SPR26/2601

“All internal affairs records for [an identified individual][.]”

Claiming to not yet have received responsive records, Mr. Quemere petitioned this office and these appeals, SPR26/2599 and SPR26/2601, were opened as a result.

Despite being notified of the opening of these appeals, it remains unclear whether the Department has provided a response(s). Accordingly, the Department is ordered to provide Mr. Quemere with a response(s) to his requests, provided in a manner consistent with this order, the Public Records Law and its Regulations within ten (10) business days. A copy of any such response(s) must be provided to this office. It is preferable to send an electronic copy of the response to this office at pre@sec.state.ma.us. Mr. Quemere may appeal the substantive nature of the Department’s response(s) within ninety (90) days. See 950 C.M.R. 32.08(1).
